Cumberland County Schools is seeking qualified reading tutors in partnership with North Carolina Education Corps to provide high-impact literacy tutoring to K-3 students. Each Corps tutor will work with groups of 1 to 3 students in kindergarten through 3rd grade, to aid them in learning fundamental reading skills based on the Science of Reading.

Minimum Requirements: Associates or Equivalency of 40 Hours College Credit, Bachelors' Degree and/or NC Teaching License Experience will receive certified pay, Approved Background Check is required

Reports To: Principal/ Instructional Coach/NCEC Coach

Duties and Responsibilities

- Promotes learning success and acceleration by providing high-impact tutoring in Early Reading Strategies and Interventions.
- Assists teachers with individualized academic and social-emotional support for K-3 students during the school day
- Provide high-impact literacy tutoring focused on phonics and phonemic awareness and aligned with the science of reading for K-3 students most impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Support students in alignment with the North Carolina State Board of Education's principles of Whole Child, Equity, and Excellence in North Carolina public education.
